In our September 2022 Newsletter, we highlighted an unfortunate situation that had befallen one of our needy girls. We reached out to well-wishers who would be willing to assist the girl seek urgent medication.

Thanks to the Almighty God, one of our sponsors who was really touched by the girl's condition contacted us and agreed to cater for transport, consultation and lab costs plus a subsequent cost of biopsy.



However, we are saddened to report that the girl was diagnosed with a malignant tumour.

The doctor requested that she undergoes a CT Scan to determine the extent of spread of the disease to her chest, abdomen and pelvic area by mid November before she returns for a review and a possible treatment plan be put in place for her from there henceforth.



Moreover, we are not sure yet what treatment plan would be put in place for her neither do we nor the family have the resources to make her go through it. The family has no alternative source either. Instead, all their hope is on us. It is for this reason that we request and call upon any other willing and interested party to kindly come to our aid.
